Whereas the See and Diocese of Lucknow in this Church is presently vacant, pending the election of a Bishop thereto; and

Whereas during the Vacancy in the See it is expedient for the good order and government of the said Diocese of Lucknow that a Priest resident in that Diocese be appointed as the Archdeacon thereof; and

Whereas towards this end We have obtained the advice and consent of the Bishops of India:

We do by these Presents give and grant unto you, in whose Fidelity, Morality, Learning, Sound Doctrine and Diligence We do fully confide, our Licence and Authority to perform the Office of

within Our said Province of India, in performing those Ecclesiastical duties belonging to the said Office, acting always in consultation with the Episcopal Visitor to the Diocese of Lucknow, with the advice and consent of the Guardians of the Spiritualities of the See of Lucknow, and in accordance with the Constitutions and Canons of this Church, Province and Diocese and such Regulations and directions made pursuant thereto and pertaining to such Office and Appointment.
