IN THE NAME OF GOD AND OF HIS HOLY CHURCH. AMEN.

To all the Faithful in Christ Jesus throughout the World to whom these Presents shall come: Greeting.

Be it known by these presents that, acting on behalf of JAMES BROMLEY, the then Bishop Ordinary of the Missionary Diocese of Australia and Metropolitan of India and the Titular bishop of Calcutta of the Church of India(Anglican),CIPBC, being the second Province of the Anglican Catholic Church, We JOHN CHARLES, Archbishop of the Diocese of New Orleans and Metropolitan of the Original Province of the Anglican Catholic Church, together with Our comprovincials; MARK HAVERLAND, Bishop Ordinary of the Diocese of the South and ROMMIE STARKS, Bishop ordinary of the Diocese of the Mid-West; On the Twenty-second Day of October, being the Feast of the Martyrs of New Guinea, in the year of our Lord Two Thousand and Three, at the Fifteenth Synod of the Original Province, in the city of Metairie, in the State of Louisiana, before the clergy and people of the Original Province of the Anglican Catholic Church, conferring the Mysteries of Jesus Christ our Lord under the protection of Almighty God,did,then and there,advance,promote,elevate,and admit Our beloved Brother in Christ,

In testimony whereof, we have hereunto subscribed our hand and have caused our seal Episcopal to be affixed to these Presents.

Given and done by us at the XVth Provincial Synod, in the city of Metairie in the State of Louisiana on the day in the year above written, and in the Forty-Fourth year of Our Consecration and of Our Episcopate the third.
